Brief information about the training course	The training course is designed to provide participants with the necessary knowledge which is requisite to determine the theoretical and practical principles of functioning the national economy of Ukraine in terms of its reform, implementation of sustainable development strategy and post-war renovation. The training course presents both an overview of the basic concepts and factors of Ukraine’s economic development, as well as the processes and tools needed to specify modern models of reforming, analyze the economic, social and environmental consequences of reforms and military aggression. The training course takes into account the peculiarities of the student’s future activities.
Brief abstract of the training course	The training course “Economy of Ukraine” is the final normative training course in the speciality 051 “Economics” for the educational programme “Economics”, which is taught in the Spring (second) semester in the amount of 3 credits (according to the European Credit Transfer System ECTS).
The main aim and goals of the training course	The aim of studying the normative training course “Economy of Ukraine” is to acquaint students with the theoretical and applied principles of the functioning of the national economy in the conditions of its reform and post-war reconstruction, which is focused on identifying factors, problems and features of its development, modern models of its reform, primary analysis of the economic, social and environmental consequences of reforms and military aggression.

Written works: Students are expected to complete several types of written works (essays, case studies).

Academic integrity: Students' work is expected to be their original research or reasoning. Lack of references to sources used, fabrication of sources, copying, interference in the work of other students are, but are not limited, examples of possible academic dishonesty. Detection of signs of academic dishonesty in the student's written work is the basis for its non-inclusion by the teacher, regardless of the extent of plagiarism or deception.

Attending classes is an important part of learning. It is expected that all students will attend all lectures and practical classes of the training course. Students should inform the teacher about the impossibility of attending classes. In any case, students are required to meet all deadlines set for all types of written work provided by the training course.

Literature. All literature that students will not be able to find on their own will be provided by the teacher exclusively for educational purposes without the right to transfer it to third parties. Students are also encouraged to use other literature and sources that are not among those recommended.

Grade policy. The points gained on the current testing, independent work and the points of the final testing are taken into account.
